Dawn House School Year on Year Student Progress Results



Both Core and Foundation subjects have moved away from levelling and are using a system based on stages. These stages are based around the Age Related Expectations (ARE) for students in KS1, 2 and 3. Students are assessed and placed on the appropriate stage when they start at the school.

Target progress is set at 66% of mainstream progress (Against age related expectations). That is to say 66% of one stage per year.
