(Human Papillomavirus Vaccine)!

This vaccine is offfered to all young people in:



Year 8

This vaccine is part of the Childhood Immunisation Programme and consists of 2 doses given in school between 6 and 24 months apart.

Please Note: Once you have completed a consent form it will stand for both doses of the HPV vaccination.

Having the HPV vaccine helps protect both boys and girls from Human Papillomavirus related cancers.

The decision to have the vaccination is legally your son / daughter's as long as they understand the reasons for the vaccination and the issues in giving consent, however, the nurse would much rather have your permission too.
