- KS4 LC – New mini bus

- KS3 AD/DE – More laptops and OT equipment
- KS3 AR – Cricket equipment, more glue in classroom, football kit and sport kit, sport bibs, basket ball court
- KS4 MW – Each form has a trip out
- Primary 2 – More laptops and iPads and outdoor gym
- KS3 JC – More PE equipment, golf course on the field, new mini bus
- Junior – Laptops and sensory items

- KS4 MW – Don't share personal information and let parents know of anything that upsets you

- Primary 2 – Don't share personal information, don't view explicit content, if you're being bullied online tell an adult, be careful when online gaming and don't talk to strangers, don't use unkind words
- KS3 JC – Not much shared – but Elly says about not sharing personal information being important
- KS3 AD/DE – Don't answer to people you don't know, tell an adult if something upsets
- KS3 AR – Do not send photos of yourself, only message people you know, don't share passwords, don't share your address, check with your parents before visiting websites
- Junior – same as above
- KS4 LC – Keep personal details safe, have social media accounts set to private, only accept friend requests if you know them
- Primary 1 – Don't talk to strangers, don't share your personal information
- KS4 SW – Use YouTube for appropriate videos only, be sensible when online
